## **SATURDAYS, SUNDAYS AND PUBLIC HOLIDAYS A MANDATORY BIKE BOOKING SERVICE AT 1€ PER BIKE\***

**From March 30, 2024, all Rémi and Rémi Express trains on the following railway lines :**

- ▶ Paris – Montargis – Nevers
- ▶ Paris – Les Aubrais / Orléans – Blois-Chambord – Tours (except trains Loire à Vélo n°8600XX\*\*)
- ▶ Paris – Les Aubrais / Orléans – Vierzon
- ▶ Tours – Vierzon – Bourges – Nevers (except trains no. 8607XX, 16840 and 16848)

More and more passengers want to take Rémi trains with their bikes. In order to better meet this demand and to make your travel easier this summer, the Centre-Val de Loire Region and SNCF Voyageurs guarantee all travelers (travel pass holders and passengers with train tickets) a place for their bicycle within the limits of the places available on these Rémi lines, via the purchase of a bicycle booking at €1 per bicycle and per train.



### **HOW TO TRAVEL WITH PEACE OF MIND WITH MY BIKE ON TRAINS WITH MANDATORY BIKE RESERVATION?**

#### **How to travel in order?**

To be in order and travel with your bike, you will need to have a train ticket or travel pass and a bicycle reservation at the single rate of €1 per bicycle and per train. Trailers, tandems, cargo bikes and recumbent bikes are not allowed on board.

#### **Anticipate your bike booking**

Reservations are open for sale on the Rémi website.

**You are responsible for your bike during the entire trip, as well as during loading and unloading.**

#### **Before my journey**

- ▶ As the number of bicycle places is limited, I make my booking as soon as possible and preferably 48 hours before the planned travel date.
- ▶ I check the availability of bike spaces before buying my train ticket.
- ▶ The bicycle booking purchased is only valid on the train chosen at the time of purchase.

#### **The day of my trip**

- ▶ I arrive 20 minutes before the departure of the train and I label my bike with the printed booking coupon beforehand.
- ▶ I remove the baskets from the bike.
- ▶ I look for the bicycle pictogram on the train and place the bicycle in the dedicated space.

#### **During my trip**

- ▶ For safety reasons, the bicycle must not interfere with doors, emergency exits and areas reserved for people with reduced mobility.
- ▶ In case of difficulty, I approach the Rémi personnel.

**In case of overcrowding and without a valid bicycle booking, SNCF reserves the right to refuse bicycles access on board.**

#### **Refund request**

- ▶ This bike reservation is refundable and exchangeable until the departure time indicated on the booking, via the Rémi website.
